President's Message - December, 2020

Perhaps, we may have a belated celebration and BBQ next summer!

A club thrives and survives through the contributions of its members and volunteers. Jefco Aeromod'lers members have kept our club going through good times and bad times over the past 60 years with their involvement and support. Along with their donations, members have volunteered their time and skills, intellect and experience. Thank you to each and every one, who either in the past or present, have volunteered and made significant and meaningful contributions to sustain the existence and improve the operations of Jefco Aeromod'lers RC Club.

Board of Directors

Your Board of Directors has been diligently working behind the scenes to keep the club's "wheels turning". We are conducting Board Meetings online, and making every effort to manage club business in good faith, doing the best we can under these unusual circumstances. We are updating the Field Safety Manual, negotiating a new Park Agreement, planning for possible events next summer, designing and developing new and accurate field graphics, and assembling the 2021 Operating Budget. Projecting an accurate budget is a very difficult task with so many unknowns at this time. What we do know is that Covid-19 and its associated problems are still here. Experts say, even with the hopes of an effective vaccine on the horizon, the physical, emotional and devastating economic effects of this virus, will be with us well into next year, and for many even longer.

We are scaling back 2021 Budget projections, both income and expenses, based on this disturbing reality. For a number of reasons related to Covid-19, we have determined it prudent to cancel the 2021 Auction at the Arapahoe County Fairgrounds. In its place, we are exploring the concept of an online, silent auction sometime after the first of the year, perhaps in the spring. This will provide an outlet for modelers to sell unwanted or excess items in their inventory, and a place for others to pick up that item they've been looking for, or never knew they needed. If the details and programming can be worked out so this works well and is user-friendly, it will at least feed our "auction fever", and will serve as a mechanism to provide some revenue to the club as well. Thank you in advance, Terry Hock, for your efforts and expertise as you take on this challenging task.

Runway Striping

As previously reported, the runway striping and lettering project is scheduled for next spring after the snow season has ended. Snow Skiing

Since the area between the east end of the pits and the old N/S runway, where we previously flew our snow and ski planes, can no longer be used, we are experimenting with a new designated area. This area will be approximately 40 yards wide and run parallel to the north side of the E/W runway. Use of this area for skiing will be determined on a first-come, first-served basis and when in use, it will be considered the active runway. November 5, 2020 Jefco Aeromod'lers R/C Club Board of Directors Virtual Meeting Minutes

This meeting was held via a virtual meeting platform. While the club bylaws do not say that virtual meetings can be held and considered a formal board meeting, the bylaws don't say they can't. Therefore in the best interest of continuing business of the club (as there is no hope in sight to be able to safely meet in person due to pandemic concerns), the Board decided to meet virtually as a formal meeting and will continue into the future as necessary.

CALL TO ORDER/WELCOME: President Bud Glass called the meeting to order at 7:09pm.

5 of 6 board members were in attendance. A quorum was present.

All members attending this meeting were visually present with properly working audio.

PRESIDENT'S COMMENTS/ANNOUNCEMENTS:

President Bud Glass thanked the board members for their continued efforts taking care of club business during these challenging pandemic times. He also thanked Craig Farthing for setting up the meeting link.

Motion: Larry Fagan made a motion for the Jefco club Board of Directors to meet via virtual platform moving forward. This will ensure that the business of the club can still be efficiently and productively managed. Josh Waltz seconded the motion. All directors present were in favor of the motion. Motion carried.

When the club is back to live in-person monthly club meetings, the bylaws will be updated and amended to formally allow virtual/video board meetings to be held when in-person meetings are not possible. It is still expected that nominations and election of board officers must still be held in-person unless other solutions are realized.

OLD/UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

<u>Safety Manual Updates</u> – The Board has reviewed the current document and has submitted a first round of suggested edits and additions to Lora Knowlton, who is compiling everything. Moving forward, the board expects to have several more rounds of review with additional virtual meetings.

NEW BUSINESS:

<u>Solar Charging and Field Security</u> – the Board discussed electronic field security and solar battery charging systems. Currently, getting electricity at the field in the right locations is an issue. Solar systems may not provide the power that is needed. More discussion is expected.

<u>2021 RC Auction</u> – this is the time of the year that planning dials in for the upcoming RC Auction. The 2021 Auction has been tentatively scheduled for January 25, 2021 at the Arapahoe County Fairgrounds (ACF). The Board discussed pros/cons of moving forward with event planning.

• Earlier this year, the ACF was used as an alternative care center for COVID-19 patients. For 2021, the club has been notified that while the club is on their calendar for January 25, the facility could be mandated

to return to a care center with little to no advance notice.

- State guidelines in January could be such that indoor events might be more regulated than they are now. In other words, if only 50 were allowed at an indoor event, the club would need to have a process in place to regulate attendees.
- Would attendance be less than the January 2020 event? Could volunteers be easily found to work the event?
- Most importantly, what is the financial risk to the club if the auction was cancelled within days of the event?

Board members were not comfortable moving forward with plans for the 2021 RC Auction. All agreed that it was in the club's best interest to suspend/cancel the traditional RC auction for 2021 and to explore alternatives for club fundraising opportunities. Briefly discussed was having an online auction sometime in the spring. Stay tuned as the board filters through ideas.

Motion: Josh Waltz made a motion to cancel the 2021 RC Auction scheduled for January 25, 2021 at the Arapahoe County Fairgrounds and to explore alternative fundraising opportunities. Larry Fagan seconded the motion. All directors present were in favor of the motion. Motion carried.

Lora Knowlton will notify the ACF and club member Art Wilson (Auction computer guru) . (Post meeting note – the ACF has rescheduled the RC Auction for January 2022).

<u>2021 Budget</u> – Traditionally, this is the time of the year that the Board pulls together a draft budget that is then presented to the club members in December for approval. Since club meetings are not being held in person due to pandemic restrictions, the budget will obviously not be presented next month. Despite this, the Board felt strongly that they could still work on a draft budget and get it to the point where it would be ready to be presented to the club. Treasurer Lora Knowlton will craft two draft budgets – one reflecting no auction and another reflecting an online auction and no events until June. She asked board members to send her project Continued Page 5, left column

suggestions with financial info to be compiled and incorporated into a prelim budgets. The Board will meet again soon to discuss the draft budgets.

<u>Club Meetings in December 2020 and January 2021</u> – Rather than cancelling club meetings (due to pandemic restrictions) on a month-to-month basis, the Board discussed cancelling both the Dec 2020 and Jan 2021 meetings now. In mid-January, February and March meeting status will be discussed. How would have ever thought the club would be cancelling club meetings for nearly a year!!??

Motion: Craig Farthing made a motion to cancel the Dec 2020 and Jan 2021 club meetings. Josh Waltz seconded the motion. All directors present were in favor of the motion. Motion carried.

<u>Shea Homes "Good Neighbor" Plan</u> – the Board discussed creating a plan to "interface" with Shea Homes HOA. This could be brochures, memberships, open house in the spring, etc. Josh Waltz, club Community Relations chair will coordinate the effort.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

Treasurer Lora Knowlton presented the financials to date via email to the Board. Balance Sheet (as of Nov 4) reflects all account balances to date. The Profit & Loss Statement (as of Nov 4) – shows income with membership revenue has slowed down a bit since last reported and expenses – runway sealing/crack filling and weather station upgrades took place.

Always notify the flight line pilots of your intentions. <u>NEVER</u> walk out onto the runway without notifying the pilots flying. If you see someone not complying, please bring this safety infraction to their attention. With this being an open airfield, not all pilots are familiar with our safety guidelines and rules. Most of the time it is just a matter of educating the pilot.
